The wickedness of human kind:

• Gen 6:5-7 TLV(5) Then Adonai saw that the wickedness of humankind was great on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of their heart was only evil all the time.(6) So Adonai regretted that He made humankind on the earth, and His heart was deeply pained.(7) So Adonai said, "I will wipe out humankind, whom I have created, from the face of the ground, from humankind to livestock, crawling things and the flying creatures of the sky, because I regret that I made them."

The earth was filled with violence:

• Gen 6:11-12 TLV(11) Now the earth was ruined before God, and the earth was filled with violence.(12) God saw the earth, and behold it was ruined because all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth.

Not just mankind:

- The whole creation was ruined:
 - Rom 8:18-23 TLV(18) For I consider the sufferings of this present time not worthy to be compared with the coming glory to be revealed to us.(19) For the creation eagerly awaits the revelation of the sons of God.(20) For the creation was subjected to futility—not willingly but because of the One who subjected it—in hope(21) that the creation itself also will be set free from bondage to decay into the glorious freedom of the children of God.(22) For we know that the whole creation groans together and suffers birth pains until now

• The creation groans; we groan to be delivered:

- Rom 8:18-23 TLV —(23) and not only creation, but even ourselves. We ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Ruach, groan inwardly as we eagerly wait for adoption—the redemption of our body.
- Rom 7:24-25 TLV (24) Miserable man that I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death?(25) Thanks be to God—it is through Messiah Yeshua our Lord! So then, with my mind I myself serve the Torah of God; but with my flesh, I serve the law of sin.

- We groan for deliverance, but the world does not even know there is a problem.
- The wickedness of man is a repeating story.
 - Israel's repeated falls into sin.
 - The rise and fall of nations and peoples.
 - The prophecies of the end times.

• It will be like Noah's day when Yeshua comes:

• Mat 24:36-39 TLV(36) But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven nor the Son, except the Father alone.(37) "For just as the days of Noah were, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.(38) For in those days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day Noah entered the ark.(39) And they did not understand until the flood came and swept them all away. So shall it be at the coming of the Son of Man.

You will NOT see it coming:

• Luk 17:22-27 TLV(22) Then Yeshua said to the disciples, "The days will come when you will long to see one of the days of the Son of Man, and you will not see it.(23) They will say to you, 'Look, there!' or 'Look, here!' Do not go and chase after them.

Like lightning:

- You will not be able to react:
 - Luk 17:24 TLV (24) For just as the lightning flashes from one part of the sky and lights up another part, so will the Son of Man be in His day.
- Wanna see my fast draw?

Like the days of Noah:

• Luk 17:25-27 TLV (25) As it was in the days of Noah, so will it also be in the days of the Son of Man.(26) But first He must suffer much and be rejected by this generation.(27) They were eating, drinking, marrying, and being given in marriage, until the day Noah entered the ark. Then the flood came and destroyed them all.

The day of the Lord:

• 1Th 5:2 TLV (2) For you yourselves know very well that the Day of the Lord comes like a thief in the night.

Be ready at all times:

• Luk 12:39-40 TLV(39) But understand this, that if the master of the house had known at what hour the thief was coming, he would not have allowed his house to be broken into.(40) You also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you don't expect."

The world will think you are strange:

- 1Pe 4:3-5 TLV(3) For the time that has passed was sufficient for you to carry out the desire of the pagans—living in indecency, lusts, drunken binges, orgies, wild parties, and lawless idolatries.(4) They are surprised that you do not run with them into the same riot of recklessness, and they vilify you.(5) But they will have to give an account to the One who stands ready to judge the living and the dead.
- You are making us look bad.

The world hates having their works revealed:

• Joh 7:7 TLV(7) The world cannot hate you, but it hates Me because I testify that its works are evil.

They love darkness:

• Joh 3:19 TLV(19) "Now this is the judgment, that the light has come into the world and men loved the darkness instead of the light, because their deeds were evil.

We are hated because we are chosen:

• Joh 15:18-19 TLV(18) "If the world hates you, know that it has hated Me before you.(19) If you were of the world, the world would love you as its own. But you are not of the world, since I have chosen you out of the world; therefore the world hates you.

Do NOT be surprised:

• 1Pe 4:12 TLV(12) Loved ones, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal taking place among you to test you—as though something strange were happening to you.

Through many persecutions:

• Act 14:21-22 TLV(21) After proclaiming the Good News to that city and making many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch.(22) They were strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to persevere in faith, and saying, "It is through many persecutions that we must enter the kingdom of God."

Noah found favor with God:

• Gen 6:8-9 TLV(8) But Noah found favor in Adonai's eyes.(9) These are the genealogies of Noah. Noah was a righteous man. He was blameless among his generation. Noah continually walked with God.

God remembered Noah:

• Gen 8:1 TLV(1) Then God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and all the livestock that were with him in the ark. So God caused a wind to pass over the land and the water subsided.

God will NOT forget:

• Heb 6:10 TLV(10) For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love that you showed for His name, in having served and continuing to serve the kedoshim.

Be in shalom, spotless and blameless:

• 2Pe 3:14 TLV(14) Therefore, loved ones, while you are looking for these things, make every effort to be found in shalom, spotless and blameless before Him.

· Be on guard:

• 2Pe 3:17-18 TLV(17) Since you already know all this, loved ones, be on your guard so that you are not led astray by the error of the lawless and lose your sure footing.(18) Instead, keep growing in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Yeshua the Messiah. To Him be the glory both now and to the day of eternity! Amen.

• Mat 25:20-21 TLV(20) The one who had received the five talents came up and brought another five talents, saying, 'Master, you handed me five talents. Look, I've gained five more.'(21) His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You were faithful with a little, so I'll put you in charge of much. Enter into your master's joy!'

The holy fear of Noah:

• Heb 11:7 TLV (7) By faith Noah, when warned about events not yet seen, in holy fear prepared an ark for the safety of his household. Through faith he condemned the world and became an heir of the righteousness that comes by faith.

What kind of people should we be?

• 2Pe 3:11-13 TLV(11) Since all these things are to be destroyed in this way, what kind of people should you be? Live your lives in holiness and godliness,(12) looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God. In that day the heavens will be dissolved by fire, and the elements will melt in the intense heat.(13) But in keeping with His promise, we look for new heavens and a new earth, where righteousness dwells.
